An \$8000 price tag was also paid for a Poll Merino sire from the Kolindale stud and it was again pleasing to see stud competition on the ram with the Barloo stud, Gnowangerup, bidding up to ensure they added the sire to their battery.

Barloo stud principal Richard House said he was after a sire with a good frame and the Kolindale ram fitted the bill in terms of size and structure.

“He’s a nice big ram with good structure and good wool, which is what we were looking for,” he said.

“We have a specific group of ewes in mind for him.”

The Kolindale ram was by Collinsville Magestic, a ram purchased by the Kolindale stud in Adelaide for \$39,000 in 2010.

Wool tests had the ram sitting at 21.8 micron,
